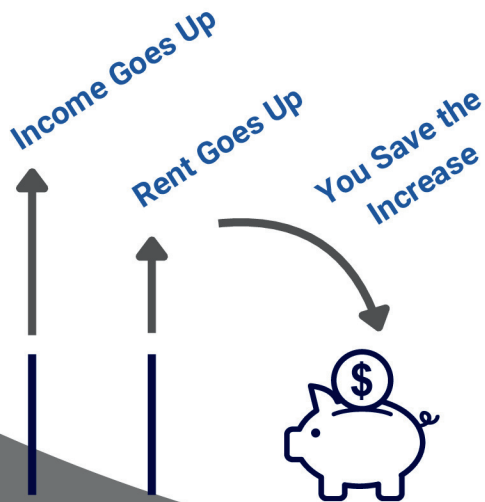


Earn Savings as You Participate

- An increase in your rent because of an increase in earnings from work will result in a credit to your account.
- To complete the program, you must be suitably employed, free of cash welfare assistance, and have achieved any other goals you set. Then, the savings becomes yours!

Any SHA Affordable Housing or Housing Choice Voucher participant interested in seeking and maintaining employment within 5 years is eligible to join.

The Family Self-Sufficiency program is a self-paced coaching model that helps you build a more stable financial future for you and your family.

FSS Coaches help you identify your strengths and encourage and support you toward personal growth and employment success.

As your income from work increases, your rent increase is set aside into a managed savings account. Upon successfully completing the FSS Program, that savings account becomes yours!
